



Survey Guide


- Rapid fire exercise
 - Initial thoughts and gut reaction <u>ONLY</u>
 - Limit yourself to 10 seconds per image group
- Images contain both positives and negatives.
 - These are not perfect places
- The entirety of an image may not be completely applicable to Hickory Flat
 - Mountains, urban characteristics, palm trees
- Concentrate on architecture, materials, landscaping, building heights, walkability, land uses, etc.
 - Don't focus on company names, image locations, traffic, weather, etc.
