Centered on **great local institutions**, such as schools, recreation, the library, churches and the fire station.






Future Land Use Map

Cherokee County

Demographics and Trends

- Growing at a faster rate than the County and Region
 - ▶ Population increasing more than 140% since 2000
 - Rates expected to slow
- Missing "Millennials" and more "Boomers"
 - Attributed to lack of rental housing and higher home prices and greater availability of senior living
- Less racial diversity
- More affluent and higher education levels
 - 50%+ of household earn >\$100k per year and have college degree
- Few residents work in Hickory Flat
 - ▶ 1650 jobs but only 2% filled by residents
